We are offering subsidised training in the following:

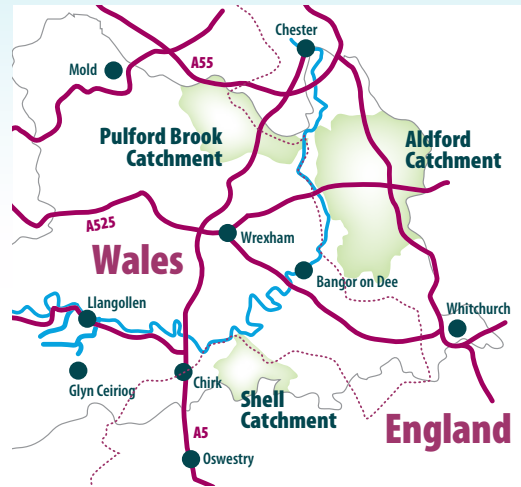
- PA1 – Compulsory foundation module for anyone applying professional pesticides in association with other PA modules

The following courses are compulsory for those using that specific equipment:

- PA2a - Mounted or trailed sprayers
- PA2f - Weed Wipers
- PA4s - Pesticide slug pellet applicators
- PA6 - Handheld & knapsack applicators
- Replacing of Grandfather Rights - For those who were previously exempt and who apply pesticides on land they own or occupy.
